A native of Rayne, Mr. Guidry lived in Gretna for many years. He worked for Associated Distributors Company, retiring as manager after many faithful years of service. Following retirement, Mr. Guidry returned to Acadia Parish for several years, and had relocated to Lumberton, MS recently to be near family.

Mr. Guidry was a member of St. Joseph Catholic Church, and he attended First Baptist Church of Rayne. He was a member of American Legion, Veterans of Foreign Wars, and Disabled American Veterans.

Survivors include his wife of over 70 years, Exaltha Landry Guidry of Rayne; daughters, Judy Windham and husband, Lamar of Brookwood, AL, Brenda Caruso and husband, Carl of Lumberton, MS, and Donna Gautreaux and husband, David of Lumberton, MS; sisters,

Marie Broussard of Rayne, and Jeanette Leger of Rayne; 7 grandchildren; and 9 great-grandchildren. He is also survived by a host of nieces, nephews, other relatives, and friends.
