She was a lifelong Rayne Garden Club member who loved creating new flower arrangements and, later in life, serving on their Judges Council. She happily held the position of the Rayne Garden Club chapter president, from 2009-2011. She looked forward to her many road trips to area flower shows throughout the state with her friends. Hazel contributed her time to the Rayne chapter of the sorority Beta Sigma Phi and enjoyed many social events and luncheons with the organization. She had a keen interest in history and was a proud member of the Daughters of the American Revolution. She beamed with pride at the many Cleanest City titles bestowed on her town by the Louisiana Garden Club Federation. A graduate of Rayne High School, she loved attending functions with her former classmates, until her health no longer allowed. Her active participation in her church parish of St. Joseph’s Catholic Church in Rayne, as well as her unyielding faith in God allowed her to meet life’s many challenges bravely, particularly in her final days.
