She was a member of St. Joseph Catholic Church. She attended Mire Elementary and graduated from Rayne High School in 1952. She was proud to be a drummer for the Wolfettes. She met her future husband on a blind date while he was stationed at Chenault Air Force Base in Lake Charles. They married on Valentine's Day in 1953. Billy

Ray McFalls was from Spring City, TN. They had the opportunity to travel for 24 years. When he retired, they returned to Rayne. She was the secretary at Rayne High for 36 years. After retirement she took care of her great grandkids. You could have seen her at any number of sporting events for her grandkids and wearing purple and gold for Rayne High. She loved all sports. She was also a huge Saints fan. You can see her frog painted like Drew Brees. She was a constant walker in our neighborhood clocking in 2-3 miles every day.
