Mire, LA - Funeral services will be held on Wednesday, February 21, 2024, at an 11:00 AM Mass of Christian Burial at Assumption of the BVM Catholic Church in Mire, LA, for Nellie Joyce Cormier, 91, who died Sunday, February 18, 2024, at Courtyard Manor Nursing Home in Lafayette, LA, eight days before her 92nd birthday.

Father Edward Duhon, Pastor of Assumption of the BVM Catholic Church in Mire will be the Celebrant of the Funeral Mass and will conduct the funeral services.

Inurnment will be in the Assumption of the BVM Mausoleum in Mire, LA. Musical selections will be provided by Valerie Andrus.

Joyce spent most of her life in the Mire Community before retiring in Lafayette. Joyce was born February 26, 1932, in Mire, LA. She was a 1950 graduate of Rayne High School where she was active in Home Economics Club and The Wolfettes. Joyce obtained her B. A. in Upper Elementary Education from the University of Southwestern Louisiana (USL) in 1953. She taught 7th & 8th grades at Branch, Armstrong and South Rayne Elementaries and also Rayne High School in Acadia Parish for 33 years retiring in 1986. Joyce was a

member of the Acadia Parish and Louisiana Retired Teachers Associations, a Charter Member of the Catholic Daughters Court #2214, The Assumption Church Parish Council and the Assumption Church Choir.

Survivors include three cousins, Allen Venable and Mona Leger of Lafayette, and Stewart Venable (Russell) of Baton Rouge, LA.

Joyce was preceded in death by her father, Clesma Cormier, mother, Pearl Mire Cormier, sister, Gloria Dale Cormier and infant brother, James Cormier.

The family requests that visitation be observed in the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary Catholic Church in Mire, LA, on Wednesday, February 21, 2024, from 9:00 AM until time of services. A rosary will be recited at 10:00 AM.
