Rayne, LA - Funeral services will be held on Saturday, September 24, 2022 at a 12:00 pm Mass of Christian Burial at St. Joseph Catholic Church in Rayne for Susan Marie Meyer Dollison, 69, who died Tuesday, September 20, 2022 at Carpenter House in Lafayette, LA.

Interment will be in the St. Joseph Cemetery #2, Mausoleum in Rayne, LA.

Rev. Brent Smith, Pastor of St. Joseph Catholic Church will be the Celebrant of the Funeral Mass and will conduct the funeral services.

Susan was born in Crowley, the oldest of eight children and was a devoted mother, grandmother and sister. She was a 1970 graduate of Rayne High School and lived between Rayne and Crowley her entire life, residing on her family homestead in Rayne since 1999. Susan was a parishioner of St. Joseph Catholic Church in Rayne and a Legacy Member of Beta Sigma Phi International Sorority.

Susan previously worked at the Acadia Soil & Water Conservation District in Crowley, Louisiana State School in Iota, and was a Legal Secretary for Gregory Reggie in Crowley. She was employed by Acadia Parish School

Board in Crowley as a Secretary, before obtaining a degree in Education and Certification in Special Education. Susan taught SPED and Resource throughout Acadia Parish, including North Crowley Elementary, Mire Elementary, Branch Elementary and Crowley High School before retiring in 2013. She returned to work as an Adult Educator for Goodwill of Acadiana from 2015-2021.
